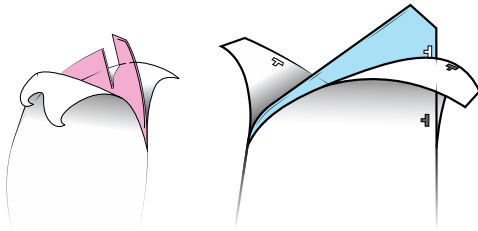


THE ORIGINAL VISOR SHIELD
Move in Close with Confidence

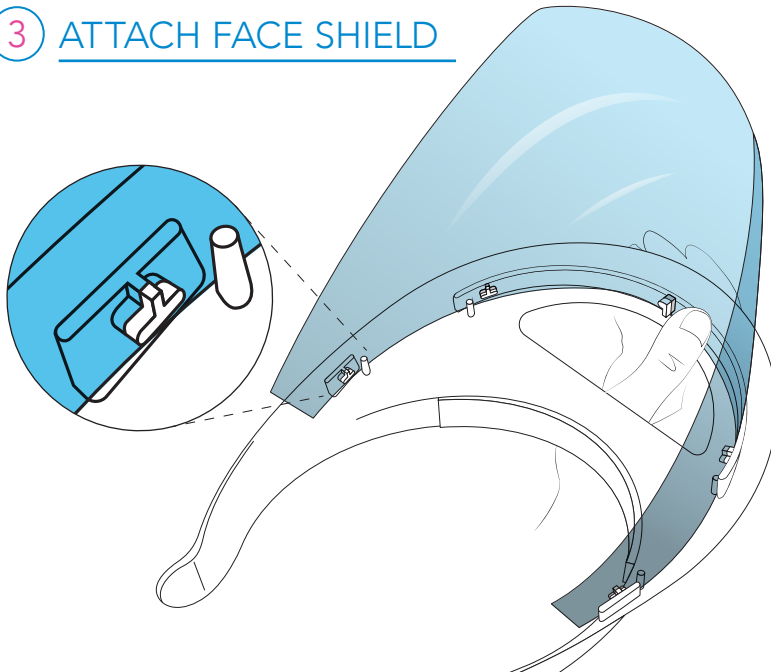
1 REMOVE MINI-SHIELD



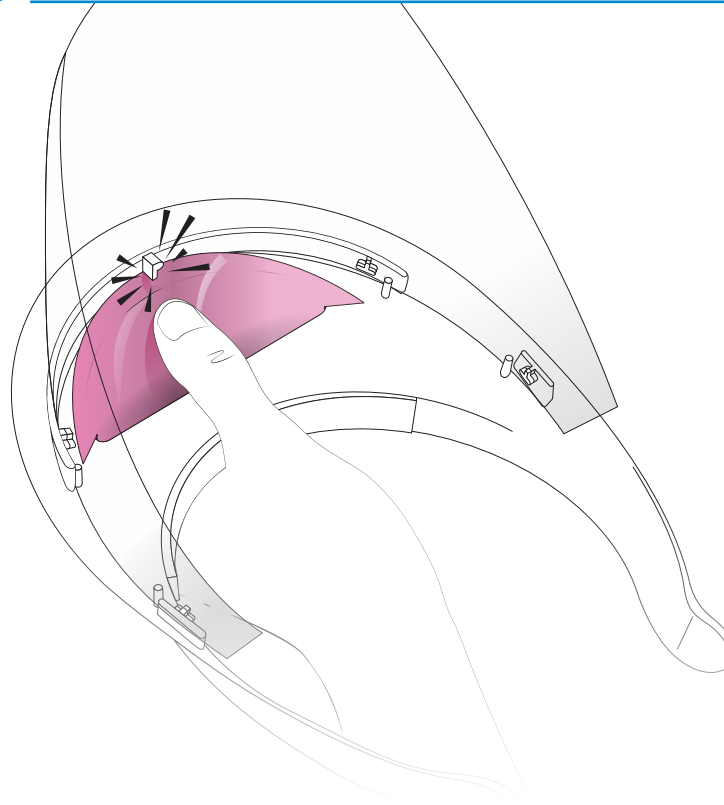
2 PEEL SHIELDS



3 ATTACH FACE SHIELD



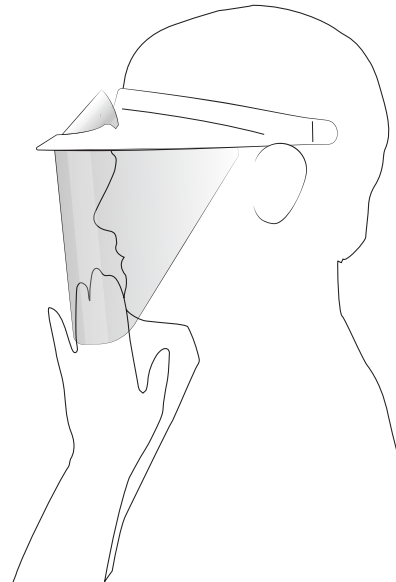
4 RE-ATTACH MINI-SHIELD



5 WEAR IT

To prevent fogging, wear your Op-d-op with the shield parallel to your face - fit two or three fingers between your chin and the shield to check.

You're ready to go!



SHIELDS TOO LONG?

If the shield touches your shoulder or chest when working, shorten the shield with scissors. Just don't cut too much off!

CLEANING YOUR OP-D-OP

If your shield is heavily splattered, properly dispose of it and replace with a new one.

To reuse shields, wash thoroughly under running water using an antimicrobial soap (like Hibiclens or Bactoshield, etc). Rinse clean and dry with a soft towel. Always keep the shield assembly right side up when cleaning.

Shields can also be cleaned using a cold sterilization solution - always follow the manufacturer's sterilizing instructions. Do not autoclave shields, or visors.

LIGHT CURING FILTERS

FOR DENTAL PROFESSIONALS ONLY

The light curing filter protects your eyes during light curing procedures. It is NOT designed or intended for use with lasers.

Peel both sides of the filter and attach it to the inside of the face shield - place it just below your line of sight and use like a bifocal.



TIME SAVING TIP:

Keep the light curing filter on an extra face shield and use exclusively during light curing procedures.
